As part of God's people we are called by God, empowered by the Holy Spirit, to share the love and grace of Jesus Christ, within our community through regular worship, faithful witness and humble service.

### Psalm 95:8-11

When we read the second half of Psalm 95, which reports God's reaction to the Israelites' complaining of thirst in the wilderness, we wonder whether God really said these words. Did God really announce that he "loathed" the Israelites who begged for water in the wilderness?

We are thirsty to hear from God, and we know that Christians primarily listen for the voice of God by attending to the words of scripture. But we also know that scripture is complicated, crafted by human beings in particular situations who were grappling with painful memories and fragile hopes. Is it possible that the writer of this Psalm engaged in what psychologists call "projection," ascribing to God their own thoughts and feelings? Maybe they were ashamed of the way their ancestors tested God and assumed God felt the same.

We still have to test the voices we hear and take time to discern whether what we are sensing is God's voice or some other voice – the internalized voice of our parents or peers for instance, or the voice of our own subconscious speaking its deep longings and fears. It gets even more complicated when we remember that God can speak to us through these other voices as well.

So we have to ask ourselves whether the voices we hear are leading us to love, compassion, self-acceptance, and joy or whether they are drawing us into negative thoughts and feelings. When we pay attention to Jesus, though he sometimes has harsh things to say, his words typically lead to abundant life,

greater joy, and genuine community. These thoughts can be helpful guidelines as we discern the voice of God, even in the words of scripture.

Prayer: God, we are thirsty to hear your voice but we know how easy it is to confuse your voice with the voices of others. Help us to hear you and respond in love.
