As part of God's people we are called by God, empowered by the Holy Spirit, to share the love and grace of Jesus Christ, within our community through regular worship, faithful witness and humble service.

Psalm 68: 1-10 A REFLECTION

A good road trip needs a good playlist. Sure, luggage and itinerary are important, but what music will you listen to along the way? What song will you sing along with at the top of your lungs forever to be associated with your holiday?

In the passage from Psalms, the psalmist sings praise to Godand invites others to join in. For those journeying with Jesus, it should sound familiar: *Sing to to God!* God who cares for orphans and protects widows, gives a home to the desolate, leads prisoners to prosperity, provides for the needy, and restores a heritage to the languishing. *Sing praises to God!*

Over and over again, the song recalls who God is and what God has done. Praise springs from remembering, and remembering is crucial for bearing witness to Christ.In order to testify, we need to know the story. How shall we remember?

This is precisely what God's people do when they gather in worship. We proclaim God's mighty acts of salvation throughout history in song and sermon, sacrament and scripture, service and study. This is our liturgy – the "work of the

people." This is the soundtrack that scores our journey as Christ's diciples. And it is no accident that so much of this liturgical work has been set to music.

Researchers have long noted a powerful connection between music and memory; they have even observed singing's restorative effects on those who have suffered brain trauma. Witnessing this is nothing short of miraculous because remembering is sacred work. But as we journey in discipleship, we can often forget where we are going and get discouraged by our distractions. To be faithful travellers, we must remember God's faithfulness – who God is and what God has done. *What do you remember?*

Prayer: O God, what refrain have I been singing lately? Is there a song that I have forgotten? Open my lips, that my mouth may declare your praise. Amen Contributed
